### 2014 Club Competition Entry Rules;

#### **ECL Bowl Competition**

This ECL Bowl Competition takes place over 8 rounds on dates specified in the Members Diary. Members can only return one card per round either on a Saturday or Sunday. The entry fee for each round will be £3.00. Players must sign in electronically before the commencement of each round.

The best Stableford score recorded at each hole will count towards each Members final score. Members do not need to play all 8 rounds but the more rounds played increases the chance of gaining points at individual holes. It is each player's responsibility to record their own score electronically after completion of each round. All Competition cards must be returned into the Competition Box. Periodic Leadership positions will be posted on the notice board in the golf shop and on-line. All rounds played in this Competition are qualifying rounds for handicap purposes. Scores will be based on members' current handicap at the start of each individual round.

In the event of a tie after the conclusion of all 8 rounds, the overall winner will be decided by that player with the most wins or the number of highest overall finishes over the 8 rounds The Competition Committee's decision on any matters relating to this Competition will be final.

### **All Regular Stableford Competitions**

These competitions will be played over the two days on the dates prescribed in the Competitions Diary. However members can only have one entry on either the Saturday or the Sunday. The entry fee for each round will be £3.00. Players must sign in electronically before the commencement of each round.

The highest Stableford score from either day will decide the Competition Winner. The normal Rules of Golf for Stableford Competitions will apply.

It is each player's responsibility to record their own score electronically after completion of each round. All cards must be returned into the Competitions Box. These Competitions are Qualifying Competitions for handicap purposes and scores will be based on members' handicap at the commencement of each individual round. These Competitions count toward the Golfer of the Year award.

The Competition Committee's decision on any matters relating to this Competition will be final.

### All Stroke/Medal Play Competitions.

These competitions will be played over the two days on the dates stated in the Competitions Diary. Members can only have one entry on either the Saturday or the Sunday. The normal Rules of Golf for Stroke Play Competitions will apply. The entry fee for each round will be £3.00. Players must sign in electronically before the commencement of each round. The lowest Nett Scores from either day will decide the Competition winners. (Nett scores are computed by Gross Scores less full handicap) It is each player's responsibility to record their own score electronically after completion of each round and all cards must be returned into the Competitions Box. These Competitions are Qualifying Competitions for handicap purposes and scores will be based on members' handicap at the start of each individual round. These Competitions count toward the Golfer of the Year award. The Competition Committee's decision on any matters relating to this Competition will be final.

#### Club Match Play Championship and Club Match Play Shield.

Entry dates for Match-Play Competitions are listed in the 2014 Diary of Competitions. Individual rounds must be completed by the dates shown on the draw sheets which will be posted in the clubhouse. It is the responsibility of both players to arrange and complete any match by the due date playable. If on the final due date playable of any stipulated round, in any Match Play Competition, a Competitor makes himself available to play by presenting himself at 2.00 p.m. at the clubhouse and his opponent fails to appear, the available player will progress to the next round as his opponent will be deemed to have forfeited the match. If neither player makes himself available at the stipulated time of 2.00p.m. on the final due date of the Competition then both players are disqualified from that Competition. All Members are eligible to play in both the Match Play Championship and Match Play Shield Competitions. Entry fee of £3.00 is payable **before** the commencement of 1st round of each Match Play Competition. Failure to comply with this rule results in automatic disqualification and the opponent progresses to the next round. There are no exceptions to this rule. The Competition Committee's decision on any matters relating to these Competitions will be final. The Winners of both Matchplay Competitions qualify for entry to the Champion of Champions. Competitors may not play concurrently in Match-Play and a Stroke/Stableford Competition. Failure to observe this rule will result in disqualification from both Competitions. On completion of the Match-Play Championship and of the Match-Play Shield the winners will play-off for the right to hold 'The Braggers Trophy'

### **Match Play Rules**

3/4 Full Handicap allowance; Example; If a player who plays off a handicap of 24 competes against a player with a handicap of 16 the player playing of the handicap of 24 receives 6 shots. These 6 shots would be taken on those holes with indexes 1 to 6. If the Match goes beyond the 18th hole then the player with the 24 handicap has another 6 shots which he can allocate, however the 6 shots can only be allocated against those holes with an index of between 1 and 6. **Mid-Week Competitions.** 

The Midweek Spring Trophy, The Midweek Summer Cup and The Midweek Autumn Cup can be played on either, <u>Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday</u> of any given week. Each Competition will be Stableford format. The entry fee for each round will be £1.00. There are a total of 8 rounds with the best 5 rounds counting In order to facilitate administration of the Competition final tee-off times are requested to be no later than 6.30p.m. The Mid-Week Summer Cup is an 18 hole 'Qualifying' Competition and will be held Mid-Weekly commencing the 27th May and concluding on 21st August. There are a total of 13 rounds with the best 8 rounds counting.

In order to facilitate administration of the Competition final tee-off times are

The Overall Winners of the Spring Trophy and the Mid-Week Summer Cup qualify to compete for the Champion of Champions Trophy.

The Mid Week Autumn Cup is a 'Non-Qualifying' 12 hole Competition (Holes No's 1 - 12 ) and will be held Mid-Weekly commencing the 26th August and concluding on 16th October. There are a total of 8 rounds with the best 5 rounds counting.

#### Winter League.

The 2014 Winter League will be an 18 hole Non-Qualifying Competition commencing on Monday 29th September. There are a total of 10 rounds with the best 6 rounds counting towards the overall winner. The Winter League can be played on any day of the week.

### The Round Dozen. (12 Rounds of 12 Holes)

The Round Dozen Competition will be played after the conclusion of the Winter League and will commence on Monday 8th December 2014 and conclude on Sunday 1st March 2015. The Round Dozen can be played on any day of the week and is a 12 hole Non-Qualifying Stableford, Competition (Holes 1-12) to be played over 12 rounds with the best 6 rounds counting towards the overall winner. The Competition Committee's decision on any matters relating to these Competitions will be final.

### G.U.I. and Cowdy Competitions.

Competitors in G.U.I. and Cowdy Competitions have priority over the course during play in either Competition.

### **Champion of Champions Trophy.**

Participation in the MGC Champion of Champions Competition, to be held on Saturday 26th October, is restricted to members only. Eligibility for entry to the Competition is strictly as follows, Order of Merit Winner. Any member who has won a Week-end Qualifying Competition during the year, (inc ECL Bowl, Medal Competition or Stableford Competition) The Overall Winner of The Spring Trophy. The Overall Winner of the Midweek Summer Cup. The Match-Play Cup Winner. The Match-Play Shield Winner. Any winner of a Major Competition such as The Subway Open Spring Classic, The Mid-Summer Shotgun, The Presidents Cup, Captains Day or The Mayobridge Masters. In the event of a visitor winning any of the Open Major Competitions then the highest placed member in that Competition gains entry.

### **GUI Handicap 17 or over**

Play off the Blue tees in comps and eligible to win Junior Prizes Only. Junior competition prizes are dependent on the number of junior playing in a comp.

### GUI Handicap 13 - 16

Play off White Tees in competitions, can compete in Senior competitions if they wish excluding majors, if doing so they must pay senior competition entry fee (usually £3) and must have a Senior member mark their competition card.

#### GUI Handicap 12 or under

Play off White Tees in competitions, can compete in Senior competitions if they wish including majors, if doing so they must pay senior competition entry fee (usually £3) and have a Senior member mark their comp card.

Junior Members under the age of 18 are not eligible to enter 2's competitions.
